Aloha and welcome to our Annual Report 2010. This has been a year of many transitions for the Resource Center including adding new Directors, establishing ourselves in a beautiful historic building at the gateway to the district and proudly observing the growth and success of two nonprofits in the community that started here at NKCRC. The Hawaii Wildlife Center's facility is actively under construction and the Kohala Stars Preschool has been successfully serving families for 6 years. We congratulate these two nonprofits and look forward to collaboration and success for years to come.

We welcomed two new Directors to our Board in December and bid a grateful aloha to Rose Rosimo and David Gomes. Kim Takata, project organizer for the Kohala Coqui Coalition and Bill Graham, an original founding Director of NKCRC, have joined our Board. Both Kim and Bill bring a strong commitment to the mission and vision of the Resource Center as well as successful track records in many community efforts. We extend a heartfelt thank you to all our Board members for the support and energy they bring to the Center all year long.

In September we held a community event that displayed over 50 of our sponsored projects in the Hisaoka Gym as well as entertainment by Kohala's own Rodney Cazimero and Melveen Leed. A special Mahalo to Joe Carvalho and Sharon Hayden. They organized this special day with more than 50 volunteers and their energetic support.

The Resource Center successfully secured over \$287,000 in donations and grants for our sixty-two active sponsored projects this past year as well as \$1.4 million for the Kohala Ditch repairs. Additionally, the Center was awarded \$34,000 in capacity building grants in 2009 from the O'Neill Family Foundation and the County of Hawaii Research and Development Department to support our building improvements. We managed to operate well within our annual budget of \$127,000 so that we continue to be financially sound during these difficult economic times.

We have begun the installation of storyboards inside the building and the construction of a lanai and public restrooms on the north face outside. So if you see carpenters' trucks and lumber in our parking area you'll know we are getting closer to opening the Kohala Welcome Center—an exciting endeavor to support the business community and share the history, highlights and beauty of North Kohala with visitors and residents alike.

We are sensitive to these challenging times and are grateful to the over 600 families and individuals and 260 businesses that have supported the Center for the past seven years. In an effort to communicate efficiently with all of you, this Report has been reduced to four pages with all our projects listed with their name and contact numbers. We plan to provide in-depth summaries and pictures of all our sponsored projects in our Summer Newsletter in July.
