### AFFORDABLE HOUSING GROUP

### BOND LIBRARY RESTORATION

Plans are set in motion for the restoration of the beloved historic Bond Library building in Kapa'au to begin in 2022.

### FEED KOHALA/NKELG

In partnership with the Sacred Heart Food Basket, Feed Kohala provides produce and protein for the food distribution every third Thursday of the month.

### GIVE AND GROW DISCOVERY SCHOOL

Serves students weekly in an outdoor learning environment where they focus on cultivating food in their giving garden to share with community.

### HO'OLA HONEY BEE RELOCATION

In 2021, Ho'ōla relocated 24 honey bee colonies from homes, businesses, and public places in North Hawai'i. Look out for new educational materials in 2022.

### KES DISCOVERY GARDEN

Creates connections for students to intergrate hands on learning in the garden for a more well rounded child and a healthy school community.

### KOHALA ARTISTS' COOPERATIVE

The co-op gallery has remained open during the pandemic and features the art of its current 36 members. Look for opportunities to participate in classes in the near future.

### KOHALA CARES

Dedicated volunteers from Kohala Cares provide bags of groceries to community members each Wednesday at 4:30 at the Kohala Village Hub.

### KOHALA COQUI COALITION

Completing two years of funding in partnership with the State of Hawaii Department of Agriculture and the County of Hawai'i, the coalition continues eradication, but relies heavily on community participation to keep infestations of coqui at a minimum.



### KOHALA RIDE WILD CLUB

Participants learn horsemanship skills and perpetuate paniolo culture through an active Pony Club, Rodeo Club and 4-H chapter.

### KOHALA REUNION

*Kohala 'Āina Ha 'aheo*, Kohala Land of the Proud, is the theme for the 5th Kohala Reunion scheduled for July 2-4, 2022 at Kamehameha Park.

### KOHALA UNUPA'A

In addition to ongoing ocean monitoring activities, Dreamstarter Clyson Marquez and fellow Kohala Unupa'a youth installed a native plant nursery during the 2021 Mauka to Makai Summer Camp.

### NĀ KŪPUNA O KOHALA

A resilient hui that just wants to dance, Nā Kūpuna o Kohala have been implementing covid safe protocols to continue practicing hula.

### NORTH KOHALA GOLF PARK

Located inside Kamehameha Park, the 9-hole golf park is open to the public for safe, physically distanced play and celebrates the installation of a new Disc Golf Course.
